

RESOLUTION 91 (V)

Status of the Treaty and its Additional Protocols

The General Conference,

Taking note with satisfaction of the fact that the Governments of the Netherlands and Great Britain have signed Additional Protocol I:

Taking note likewise with satisfaction of the fact that the Governments of Great Britain, the United States of America, France and China have signed Additional Protocol II, and

Bearing in mind the statement made at the Organization of American States by the President of the United States on April 14, 1977 that his Government had decided to sign Additional Protocol I,

Resolves:

- 1. To express its satisfaction for the statement made in regard to the forthcoming signature of Additional Protocol I by the United States of America.
- 2. To request the Secretary-General to transmit to the President of the United States of America the complacency of the General Conference of OPANAL for the above mentioned decision.

- 3. To reiterate the vigorous appeal made to the Governments of France and the Soviet Union to proceed to sign and ratify said Additional Protocols with the purpose that this zone be entirely integrated and protected against the vicissitudes that the presence of nuclear weapons entails.
- 4. To request the Good Offices Committee to intensify its efforts to achieve the implementation of this resolution with the collaboration of the Secretary-General.
