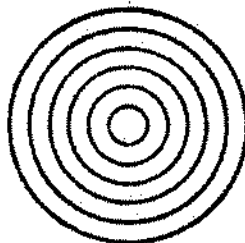

RESOLUTION 140

Status of the Convention on
Privileges and Immunities of the Agency

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind its Resolutions 37 (II), of September 9, 1971; 2 (I-E), of November 6, 1972; 50 (III), of August 23, 1973; 70 (IV), of April 17, 1975; 93 (V), of April 21, 1977, and 126 (V) of April 26, 1979, in all of which it has repeatedly called upon the Governments of the Member States that are not yet Parties to the Convention on Privileges and Immunities of the Agency, that they proceed to sign and ratify said instrument forthwith, and

Having examined the state of signatures and ratifications of the aforementioned Convention carefully, as it appears in the annex to the Secretary-General's Memorandum, included in document CG/203,

Resolves:

To request the Governments of the Member States which have not yet signed said Convention, to do so as soon as possible, and those which have signed but have not yet ratified, to do so at the earliest possible date, in order that

the legal statute of the Agency, based on Article 7 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America, may have the necessary facilities in each one of the Member States for the proper execution of its functions.
