RESOLUTION 152

Scale of Contributions for Prorating Agency Expenses
for the Fiscal Biennium 1982-1983

Report of the Committee on Contributions and Budgetary Matters

The General Conference,

Underlining the importance of the principle that all Member States of OPANAL should contribute in a just and equitable manner to the support of the Agency;

Recalling that paragraph 3, Article 9 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco establishes that:

"The General Conference shall adopt the Agency's Budget and fix the scale of financial contributions to be paid by Member States, taking into account the systems and criteria used for the same purpose by the United Nations";

Recalling likewise that the General Conference has declared in its Resolution 106 (VI) of April 25, 1979, that the application of the systems and criteria used by the United Nations Organization, to which reference is made in paragraph 3 of Article 9 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, must be accomplished in the understanding that said systems and criteria are only of an indicative nature that may serve as a procedure on which the system for the fixing of OPANAL contributions can be based;

Bearing in mind that it was established in the before mentioned resolution, the final goal should be that the maximum contributor shall give a maximum of 25 percent of the Agency's budget requirements;

Considering that this objective must be reached by a scale applied in such a way that OPANAL's finances will not be negatively affected;

Having heard the Committee on Contributions and Budgetary Matters, created by Resolution 106 (V),

Resolves:

That the Scale of Contributions of the Member States for prorating the expenses of the Agency for the fiscal biennium 1982-1983 shall conform to the following list:
