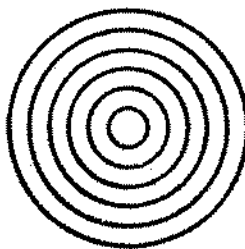

RESOLUTION 188 (IX)

STATUS OF THE CONVENTION ON THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES

The General Conference,

Mindful of previous Resolutions and particularly of Resolution 173 (VIII) dated 18 May 1983, in which repeatedly calls have been made to the Governments of Member States which are not yet Parties in the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Agency, to proceed to sign and ratify this instrument as early as possible, and

Having examined in detail the status of the signatures and ratifications of the said Convention, as it appears in the Annex to the Memorandum from the Secretary General included in document CG/269,

Resolves:

To request the Governments of Member States which have not yet signed this Convention, to do so as early as possible, and those which have signed but have not yet ratified it, to do so at the first opportunity, so that the legal status of the Agency, based on Article 7 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America may make use of the facilities which they ought to be enjoyed in each of the Member States for the full exercise of its functions.
