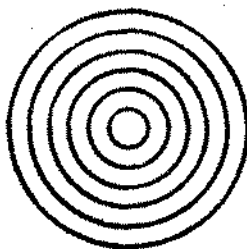

RESOLUTION 207 (IX)

DENOMINATION OF THE OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS OF OPANAL

The General Conference,

Considering that, in accordance with Article 4 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America, the zone of application of said instrument covers both the countries of Latin America and those of the Caribbean;

Recognizing the fact that the adhesion of various Caribbean States to the Treaty of Tlatelolco reflects the growing plurality of the Agency for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America,

Resolves:

To request the Secretariat General, without detriment to the legal denomination set forth in Article 7 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, to change the title of the Agency to "Agency for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean" in future documents.
