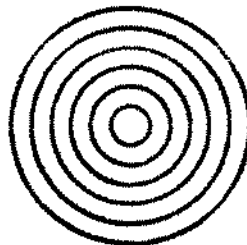

RESOLUTION 208 (IX)

EXAMINATION OF MEASURES LEADING TO THE FULL ENFORCEMENT  
OF THE TREATY OF TLATELOLCO AND THE STRICT FULFILMENT OF  
THE TREATY AND ITS ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS

The General Conference,

Having heard the general statements made by  
Representatives and Observers participating in the debates of  
the Ninth Regular Session;

Taking note with satisfaction of the unequivocal  
expression of firm adherence to the aims and principles of the  
Treaty of Tlatelolco shown by all the Representatives and  
Observers;

Considering that on several occasions the Representatives  
and Observers stressed the urgent need to take effective actions  
leading to the full enforcement of the Treaty of Tlatelolco and  
the strict fulfilment of the obligations set forth in said  
instrument and its Additional Protocols;

Recalling that, in accordance with Article 10 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, the Council of OPANAL can operate continuously and that, among others, its attributions include those assigned to it by the General Conference itself;

Resolves:

1. To entrust the Council to examine, as soon as possible, the measures that could be adopted during the next few months to contribute to the creation of conditions needed to ensure the full enforcement of the Treaty of Tlatelolco and the strict fulfilment of the obligations laid down by this instrument and its Additional Protocols.
2. To authorize the Council, once the study mentioned above has been concluded, to carry out whatever actions it deems pertinent to achieve such objectives.
3. To entrust the Secretary General and the Good Offices Committee to provide the Council with any support it may require in order to carry out the tasks entrusted to it by the General Conference.
4. To request all Governments of Member States and States associated to the Treaty of Tlatelolco to provide any collaboration requested by the Council to carry out the duties conferred on it through this Resolution.
