RESOLUTION 224 (X)

ANALYSIS OF THE WORK OF OPANAL DURING ITS TWENTY YEARS OF EXISTENCE

The General Conference,

Pointing out the important task that OPANAL has been undertaking in order to guarantee the compliance with the obligations arising from the Treaty of Taltelolco;

Considering that in 1989 the Agency will attain twenty years since its foundation;

Bearing in mind what is stated in Article 9, paragraph F, of the Treaty of Tlatelolco;

Resolves:

1. To entrust the Secretariat with the preparation of an analysis in which, both as resume and compilation, an account be made of all activities of OPANAL during its twenty years of existence. In the preparation of said analysis, which can follow a chronological order, the work and decisions of the General Conference will be separatedly considered from those of the Council as well as the work that has been realized by the Secretariat in this regard.

To request the Secretary General to submit said analysis, previously examined by the Council, to the Eleventh General Conference.

To further request the Secretary General to inscribe a new item on the Agenda of the Eleventh Regular Session of the General Conference, entitled: "Analysis of the Twenty Years of Existence of OPANAL".
