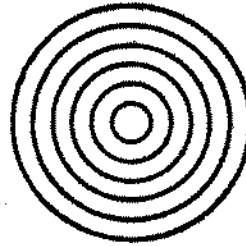

RESOLUTION 242 (XI)

ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

The General Conference,

Taking into consideration the Memorandum of the Secretary General, Doc. CG/328;

Bearing in mind that two of the Members of the Council, Costa Rica and Uruguay, finish their term of office in September 1989;

Taking into account that the Governments of Jamaica and Venezuela have presented their candidacies to occupy the vacant posts,

Resolves:

To thank Costa Rica and Uruguay for their active tenure and to accept the candidacies presented by the Governments of Jamaica and Venezuela and appoint them Members of the Council for the Agency for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean for a period of four years beginning in September 1989 and ending in August 1993.
