RESOLUTION 246 (XI)

SAFEGUARDS

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind the provisions of Article 13 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco regarding the Safeguards of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA);

Considering that it is important to reach a consensus on the possible advisability of regulating Articles 16 and 18 of the Treaty and to determine whether or not a type of Safeguards Agreements aimed specifically at the Treaty of Tlatelolco should proceed. The latter case definitely excludes any possibility of heterogeneity or multiplicity in such Safeguards,

Resolves:

To entrust the General Secretariat to prepare a study on the implications of the item of Safeguards, whether as a Safeguards Agreement based on the model that the International Atomic Energy Agency has been implementing, or as a specific Agreement for this instrument, to be submitted at the next General Conference.
