RESOLUTION CG/E/Res.404

**ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS AND
ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY MATTERS**

The General Conference,

Taking into account the Secretary General's Memorandum (Doc. CG/E/518);

Bearing in mind Article 12 of the Financial Regulations of OPANAL;

Considering that Chile, Jamaica, Mexico, Peru and Venezuela were elected per Resolution 392 (XVI), for the four-year period from January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2003;

Considering also that by the same Resolution 392 (XVI), Brazil was elected for a one-year period ending December 31, 2000,

Resolves:

To elect as Members of the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters of OPANAL the Governments of Argentina, Brazil and Colombia for a one-year period from January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2001, which aside from the powers conferred by the Treaty of Tlatelolco to the CCAAP and those assigned by the General Conference, shall ensure the correct functioning of the Financial Regulations in accordance with the provisions of such Treaty and the decisions adopted by the General Conference.
