RESOLUTION CG/E/Res. 434
ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS
AND ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY MATTERS

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind Article 12 of the Financial Regulations of OPANAL;

Taking into consideration the memorandum of the Secretary General (Doc.CG/E/551);

Considering that by Resolution 392 (XVI) Chile, Jamaica, Mexico, Peru and Venezuela were elected as Members of the CCAAP for the four-year term from January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2003;

Considering also that by Resolution 422 (XVII) Argentina, Brazil and Panama were elected for a one-year period ending December 31, 2002,

Resolves:

1. **To elect** as Members of the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters of OPANAL, the Governments of Argentina, Brazil and Panama, for a one-year term from January 1 to December 31, 2003, so that they may, in addition to the functions conferred by the Treaty of Tlatelolco on the CCAAP and those assigned by the General Conference, monitor the proper implementation of the Financial Regulations in accordance with the provisions of the Treaty and with the decisions adopted by the General Conference.
2. **To thank** the Governments of Member States and Observers of the CCAAP for their dedicated and active participation in its work.
