RESOLUTION CG/E/Res.465
BUDGET OF THE AGENCY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind the provision in Article 9 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, which establishes that the General Conference shall approve the Budget of the Agency and fix the Scale of Financial Contributions that the Member States must cover for the Agency, as well as the provisions contained in the Financial Regulations;

Taking into account the financial situation of the Member States of the Agency, the Budget for 2005 remains at a maximum of US\$ 302,490.00;

Having examined the Draft Budget for Fiscal Year 2005 (Doc.CG/E/577), presented by the Secretary General, and the recommendations formulated for that purpose by the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters,

Resolves:

1. **To approve** the Budget (attached) presented by the Secretary General for Fiscal Year 2005, which includes a maximum credit of US\$ 302,490.00.
2. **To exhort** the Member States to fulfill their financial obligations with the Agency in a timely manner.
